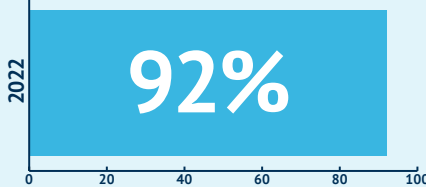


## OUR LEGACY

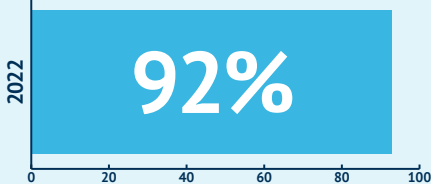

## KEEPING PEOPLE AND PETS TOGETHER

During challenging economic times, we expanded our support services and programs.

## KEEPING PETS IN HOMES

- **Our Healthy Pets events** in DeKalb and Fulton Counties provide free vaccinations, microchips and spay/neuter vouchers for families in need.
- **Our Pets for Life outreach program** connects pet owners to necessary resources in impoverished neighborhoods.
- **Our Community Support teams** help struggling pet owners find pet supplies, veterinary care and other resources. **We had 1,794 cases in 2022!**
- **Our Stay Together Fund** provides veterinary services at our Community Animal Center clinic for those who couldn't otherwise afford them.

In 2022, we struggled with shelter overcrowding for 12 consecutive months. Adoption rates declined by over 20%, creating a ripple effect with animals staying in our shelters longer. Despite many challenges, we still reached no-kill save rates throughout the year, thanks to a dedicated group of staff members, volunteers and community liaisons.
