
A DECADE OF TRANSFORMATION

Over the last decade, LifeLine has ushered in a new model of lifesaving focused on keeping pets and people together. A lot has changed in animal welfare since we took over managing the Fulton and DeKalb county shelters in 2013. During our tenure, new shelter facilities opened in both counties, the lifesaving rates substantially increased, and more lives were saved through innovative outreach programs and efforts.


